

### Protect your trademark from revocation

Cancelled for reasons it could have failed to register initially



# **WHY** would it register in the first place?

# Make sure your application is as **Solid** as possible





### After your *fifth* birthday, the grounds for cancellation are:



Your mark has become generic



Your mark is functional



Your trademark hasn't been used for a long time

Your application was *fraudulent*, *deceptive*, *immoral*, *comprises* of a name






### If there is an *issue*:

- The other party will file a petition for cancellation with the TTAB
- Must be signed by petitioner or legal representation
- Must send a fair notice of filing





# Your trademark has been CANCELLED








# You have **60 days** from the time of cancellation to appeal the decision The

# Make sure you work with Witmart in the first place

# The other party has **20 days** to get the decision reexamined







### Protect your trademark



Prove that:

- business


1. You're the bona fide holder of your trademark 2. Other party uses the trademark in sale... 3. Their trademark can be confused with yours 4. Confusion/infringement is damaging to your

# If you are successful:

- You'll receive *injunctive* relief and
- Monetary relief:
  - Repayment of losses
  - Profit made by defendant using infringing mark
  - Court costs
  - Corrective advertising









Court proceedings are very time-consuming Protect yourself by filing for a preliminary injunction or in urgent situations, a temporary



### Your defenses include...



### Laches

Unreasonable delay of the plaintiff in filing the lawsuit



### **Unclean hands**

Prove the plaintiff has acted inequitably or illegally



### Fair use

Plaintiff's trademarks are functional and descriptive



### **Amendment Free Speech**


Argue against likelihood of confusion if products are meant as a parody or self-expression
